What We Do

The center provides English as a Second Language and life skill courses for parents, early childhood programming, out of school time programs for children and teens, and outreach to the community.

Get Involved

- Volunteers are always needed to provide homework tutoring and mentoring for our K-12 programs. A background check is required as well as a minimum commitment of 1-2 hours a week for at least one semester.
- Volunteers can get trained through the English Skills Learning Center in order to teach English as a Second Language to refugees and immigrants.
