Programs

- **TEAM PAL (Together Everyone Achieves More)** – an after school program at Granite Park Jr. High, focused on community service & peer leadership initiatives.
- **PAL Mentoring** – provides the opportunity to build structured & trusting relationships between young people and caring mentors.
- **PAL Pete Suazo Boxing Center** – youth first participate in an hour of homework & tutoring, then move on to their choice of boxing or various other fitness or arts activities.
- **NFL Flag Football** – an after school program at Granite Park Jr. High in the spring and fall for boys and girls, 12-14 years old.
- **Street Hockey** – games held throughout the summer at various community events.
